Breaking Barriers

4 in 10 children are excluded from the public education system in Honduras primarily due to economic barriers (cost of school supplies, food, transportation, and uniforms). El Hogar provides those things so that no child is left behind.

Learning with Purpose

Students gain academic knowledge, hands-on skills in electricity and welding, individualized academic support and experiences that prepare them for further education and meaningful work

A Community that Empowers

Caring staff, volunteers and partners help students build confidence, resilience and hope for the future.

YOUR IMPACT THROUGH DIRECT SERVICES



- **250** students enrolled in elementary and secondary education
 - 46% girls & 54% boys



- **60** children in the residential program
- **100%** Graduation Rate (compared to 42% national average)



- Average class size of **21** (compared to 40 national average)



- Over **47,000** school lunches and snacks served!
- **15,540** kms driven to remove transportation barriers and make sure our students get to and from school safely



- **423** dental procedures completed on students
- **13** senior students completed their professional

YOUR IMPACT THROUGH COMMUNITY

El Hogar's impact extends beyond the classroom and through relationships with visitors, partners and advocates who help strengthen our mission.

In 2025, we hosted **4 visiting groups** from Episcopal churches in the US and **2 dental brigades** from Sharing Smiles.

32 visitors traveled to Honduras to immerse themselves in our mission and witnessed the transformative impact of our work.
